Monday through Friday, from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM except on most state-recognized holidays.
Occasional Saturdays (schedule-based)



Is the BU Testing Center Open during Inclement Weather?

If classes at Bloomsburg University are compressed or cancelled, the BU Testing Center is open.
If the university is closed, the BU Testing Center is closed.

Where is the BU Testing Center Located?

- BU's Test Center is located at **411 Lightstreet Road**, Bloomsburg, PA 17815
- The entrance to the test center is in the **BACK** of the building.
- Parking is available behind the building, as well as on campus.



Where do I park?

Park behind the building in the lot closest to the building. Visitor parking is also available on campus and requires a free visitor's parking pass. Please pick up a **free visitor's parking pass** before coming to the test center at any of these locations:

- Campus Police Station, attached to Andruss Library
- Carver Hall
- Buckingham Maintenance Center
- BU Testing Center



What should I bring with me to my test?

Bring a current, non-expired Driver's License, State ID card, or Passport for identification and verification purposes. Some testing programs require examinees to bring 2 forms of valid ID. Check with your test sponsor for specific ID requirements.

NOTE: Photographs of ID on cell phones or other electronic devices are not acceptable.



What should I NOT bring with me?

- All electronic and mobile devices. This includes cell phones, smart watches, regular watches, iPads, Tablets and Computers of any kind.
- Children
- Cigarettes, Tobacco, and e-cigarettes
- Food and/or beverages
- Mechanical pencils
- Notes
- Scratch paper
- Strong perfumes and lotions
- Weapons



What tests can I use my Bloomsburg University ID card for?

The Bloomsburg University ID Card is an acceptable ID only when taking assessments for Bloomsburg University:

- ACAT Health Sciences Senior Exit Exam
- BU Foreign Language Placement Tests
- Degrees of Reading Power
- ETS Major Field Tests
- Secondary Education Pre-Calculus Readiness Assessment

NOTE: The BU ID Card is not valid identification for professional certification exams such as PRAXIS or PearsonVUE testing programs.



What if I need Special Accommodations to take a test?

All accommodations must be made through the Testing Company at the time your exam is scheduled. The Testing Company will notify the Test Center Director of necessary accommodations prior to your test being administered.
