Definition of Non-Degree Categories And Required Academic Credentials

CATEGORY 1: Adults who have not earned a Bachelor Degree and desire to enroll on a part-time basis because they are not ready or eligible to apply to be degree students. Credential Requirements: Completed application for non-degree admission, official high school transcript, or copy of GED scores. Students may take up to seven credits per semester. Credits from other colleges do not transfer into the non-degree program. Credits earned as a non-degree student will count when admitted to the university as a degree student and will transfer to other colleges. No financial aid is available. Scheduling is done through the Coordinator of Non-Degree Programs.

CATEGORY 2: Visiting students enrolled at another institution of higher education who desire to complete course work at Bloomsburg University for transfer to their home institutions. Credential Requirements: Completed application for non-degree admission and official college transcript. Students should make certain that course work pursued at Bloomsburg University will satisfy course requirements at the home institution. Students may take more than seven credits per semester, but no more than seven credits during a summer session to transfer to their home institution.

CATEGORY 3: Advance College Experience - High school students who desire to enroll in university courses must apply to the Office of Off-Campus, Summer College and ACE program. Credential Requirements: Completed application for ACE non-degree admission, official high school transcript, and a letter of recommendation from the student's school guidance counselor. Scheduling is done through the Coordinator of the ACE program. Students may take 12 credits per semester. Tuition and fees are reduced by 75% (on campus) or 50% (if held at school district).

CATEGORY 4: Students with a Bachelor Degree taking undergraduate courses. Credential Requirements: Completed application for non-degree admission and official college transcript. Students may take up to 18 undergraduate credits per semester. Scheduling is through the Coordinator of Non-Degree Programs and/or their graduate advisor. Financial aid may be available. Students interested in taking graduate-level courses must enroll as a graduate student through the Graduate Office.

CATEGORY 5: Students with academic deficiencies who desire to pursue a program of academic recovery to qualify for undergraduate degree admission. Credential Requirements: Completed application for non-degree admission, official high school transcript and official college transcript. Students may be advised by a transfer admissions counselor. Upon the request of a transfer admissions counselor, a student may take more than seven credits per semester. Scheduling is through the Coordinator of Non Degree Programs. No financial aid available.

CATEGORY 6: (NO LONGER AVAILABLE). Those interested in obtaining teacher certification should contact the appropriate education department.

CATEGORY 7: Senior citizens 60 years or older, legal residents of the U.S., and residing in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania are eligible to apply for waiver of tuition (basic credits). You are responsible for all other applicable fees. Credential Requirements: Completed application for non-degree admission, copy of proof of age such as drivers license or birth certificate. Students may be admitted to classes on a seat-available basis only.

CATEGORY 8: Students who are seeking a program in any of the two certificate areas. For more information, see page 18 or go to: www.bloomu.edu/Admissions/certificate/php. Credential Requirements: Completed application for non-degree admission, official high school transcript or GED scores, and signature of Coordinator of Non-Degree Programs. Students with previous college credits may not apply. Students may take more than seven credits per semester.

CATEGORY 9: Foreign exchange students taking classes to transfer back to their home institution. Credential Requirements: Completed Exchange Student non-degree application, verification of enrollment at a foreign college or university affiliated with Bloomsburg University. Students are advised and scheduled through their faculty liaison and are full-time.
