




## Zoom Meetings – Authentication Setting

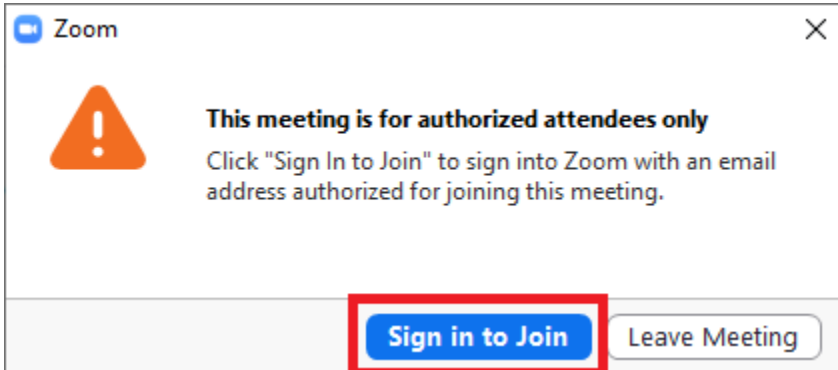
When system dialog prompts, click **Open Zoom Meetings**.

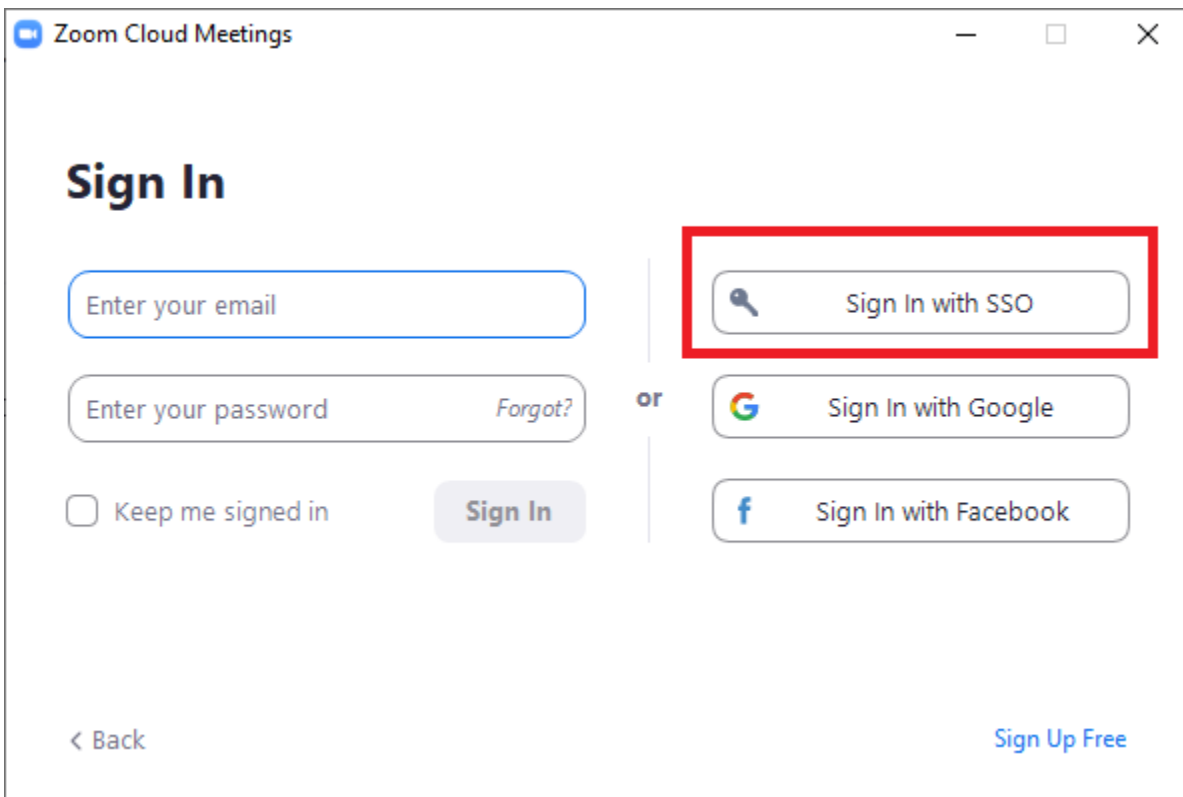
